Mr O 62,500 shares(Firm underwriting nil)



Mr P 50,000 shares (Firm Underwriting 30,000 shares)

That total application excluding firm underwriting but including marked application were 1,80,000 shares. Marked application were:

The director refunded excess application money on 2,000 shares and remaining application were allotted to allotment. All the money was duly received except the first and final call money on 1,000 shares held by luxman. His shares were forfeited by the directors of the company. These shares were re-issued to Dinesh at Rs 8 per share as fully paid up. Pass the necessary journal entries.
